



LISBON COUNCIL CONTINUES SUSPENSION OF LICENSES

Since April 2022 that the suspension of new registrations of local accommodation establishments is in force. This measure is intended to respond to the significant increase in rents and the precariousness of accommodation, seeking to prioritize the right to housing, as well as benefit affordable rent.

With the most recent approval by the Town Council of Lisbon, this suspension will be extended for an additional period of six months.

This measure is intended for parishes where there are a greater number of properties allocated to local accommodation, in a total of 15 parishes in Lisbon, namely, the parishes of Campolide, Santa Maria Maior, Misericórdia, Santo António, São Vicente, Arroios, Estrela, Avenidas Novas, Alcântara, Belém, Campo de Ourique, Parque das Nações, Penha de França, Ajuda, and Areeiro.

In this sense, those who have or intend to acquire a property in the capital in order to register it for this purpose, are still unable to do so.

This suspension will remain in force until the amendment to the Municipal Regulation for Local Accommodation comes into force or until another legal regime comes into force.
